According to U.S. Geological Survey Gauges, the water level for Lake Koshkonong is 8.13 feet, while the water level in Afton is 7.32 feet. County Ordinance requires a slow-no-wake speed restriction be placed on the Rock River when water levels exceed 8.0 feet on Lake Koshkonong and 6.50 feet in Afton.

The Sheriff's Office is providing public notice of the Rock River's current slow-no-wake status. Deputies will begin placing slow-no-wake signs along

the river at all public access points between the northern Rock County line to the West B-R Townline Road Bridge.

County Ordinance requires a slow-no-wake speed restriction on any portion of the Rock River downstream from West B-R Townline Road Bridge to the southern Rock County line when the water levels exceed 8.5 ft. The water level has not exceeded 8.5 ft in this portion of the Rock River; therefore, West B-R Townline Bridge to the southern Rock County line, along with Lake Koshkonong, will not be restricted to the slow-no-wake speed restriction.
