

Koshtoberfest pub crawl expands to include Edgerton and Milton

Koshtoberfest Pub Crawl has expanded for this year, now including 35 establishments in three loops spanning over 70 miles in the Lake Koshkonong area. Already the longest of pub crawls in Wisconsin, this expansion makes it the longest in the Midwest!

The 3rd Annual Koshtoberfest Pub Crawl, held Saturday, Oct. 10, 12:00 - 8:00 p.m., has added new loops to establishments in Edgerton and Milton, with shuttle buses running between all the stops, and allowing for riders

to move between the loops. Shuttle buses will run continuously from 1:00 - 8:00 p.m. and participants may choose to visit as many of stops as they wish, enjoying the Fall colors as they meander around the lake area. The restaurants and bars will be offering food and drink specials and live music.
