Edgerton to install bridge medallions

EDGERTON—The Rock-Koshkonong Lake District recently donated about \$1,740 to Edgerton to install six medallions on the Highway 59 bridge over Interstate 90/39 that “spotlight recreation, tourism and scenic destinations,” according to a news release.

“Our mission is to promote and protect Lake Koshkonong’s beauty and habitat for all user groups,” district Chairman Brian Christianson said. “We welcome opportunities to partner with our neighboring municipalities, both the cities and the towns, to pull more tourism and economic activity off the Interstate.”

The Interstate is slated for major expansion from the state line to Madison beginning later this year. The medallions will advertise attractions and support businesses, Christianson said.

“Lake Koshkonong could be the reason why travelers explore Edgerton and vice-versa,” he said. “Since we share an interchange, we should share in publicizing our best attributes.”
