RE: Road Repair Assistance

On Thursday, May 16, 2013, the Board of Commissioners of the Rock-Koshkonong Lake District voted to contribute \$2,500.00 to the Town of Sumner to be applied towards their claim for road repairs on North Shore Road.

It is the decision of the Board, based on meetings with RKLD and Sumner Town representatives, site visits, and consultation with the contractor, that the RKLD and its vendors complied with the existing town ordinances, including adhering to weight limits. It was also noted that a section of North Shore Road located in the Town of Koshkonong reported no damage and no claims have been made by their town board representatives.

Please note this contribution is not an admission of responsibility for the claims made against RKLD by the town.

By signing the copy included, the Town of Sumner accepts this gesture and releases RKLD of any further claims.

The meeting minutes and the appendixes will reflect the history, discussion and reasoning supporting this majority vote. The documents are available to the public and will serve as the basis to which RKLD will continue to oppose unjust claims.
