Slow/no wake restriction issued for Rock River

A slow/no wake speed restriction has been issued for the Rock River at all public access points between the northern Rock County line and the West B-R Townline Road Bridge, according to a news release from the Rock County Sheriff's Office.

A Rock County ordinance requires a slow/no wake restriction on the Rock River when the water level exceeds 8 feet on Lake Koshkonong and 6.5 feet in Afton.

The water level on Lake Koshkonong was at 8.49 feet, while the water level in Afton was at 7.62 feet Thursday morning, according to the release.

The county ordinance also requires the speed restriction on any portion of the Rock River downstream from the West B-R Townline Road Bridge to the southern Rock County line when the water level exceeds 8.5 feet.

The water level has not exceeded that measurement from West B-R Townline Road Bridge to the southern Rock County line or on Lake Koshkonong, so those areas are not affected.
