Indianford Dam Powerhouse Intake Dredging and
Trash Rack Cleaning
Town Of Fulton, Rock County, WI

The Rock-Koshkonong Lake District (RKLD) seeks a qualified contractor to undertake sediment removal and trash rack cleaning at the Indianford Dam located in the Town of Fulton Rock County, Wisconsin.

The project involves the mechanical excavation and disposal of approximately 400 cubic yards of sediment accumulated upstream of the Indianford Dam Powerhouse in the Rock River by construction of an approximate 100ft long cofferdam.

The work will be completed as water levels drop and ice conditions allow. The project completes the DNR mandated dam inspection process and a 1-year extension was recently granted by DNR to insure best weather conditions exist for cofferdam placement, excavation and trash rack inspection/cleaning.

Deadline for submitting proposals will be Friday, December 5th. Proposals must be postmarked no later than 12/5/14 and mailed to:
