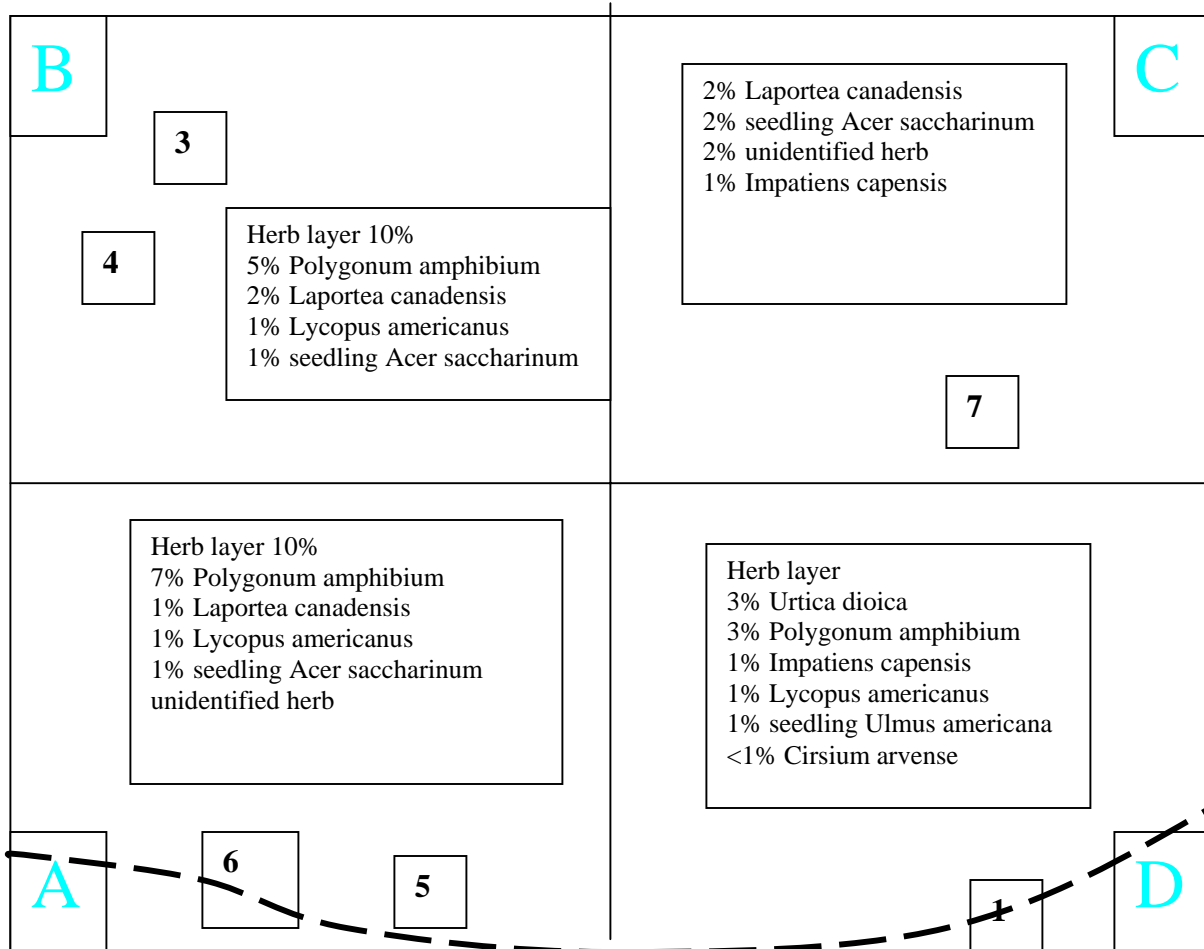


COOPERATIVE LAKE STUDY FIELD MONITORING SHEET



Location: Carcajou Floodplain Forest (N42°52'53.8", W88°58'50.7") Date: 07-16-03
 Observers: Mike Halsted & Steve Hjort Water Level: 776.30 msl
 Conditions: Clear, 50°F, light NW winds.

Quad A: **5** = *Ulmus americana*, **6** = 7" and 18" dbh double trunk *Acer saccharinum* with 1", 1", 1.5" and .75" suckers. Herb layer vegetation present. Evidence of continued erosion. Trees healthy.

Quad B: **3** = 18"dbh *Fraxinus pennsylvanica*. **4** = *Fraxinus pennsylvanica*. Herb layer vegetation present. Trees healthy.

Quad C: **7** = 22"dbh *Acer saccharinum* with 0.75", 2.5", 2.5", 2.5", 3", 3.5" suckers. Herb layer vegetation present. Trees healthy.

Quad D: **1** = *Acer saccharinum* stumps 12", 9", 7", and 6" cut off by landowner. Herb layer vegetation present. Trees healthy. Evidence of continued erosion.

Notes: Water depth 14 inches at 15' mark. Evidence of continued erosion undermining the tree roots. *Potamogeton pectinatus* observed 20 feet lakeward of plot in shallow water.
