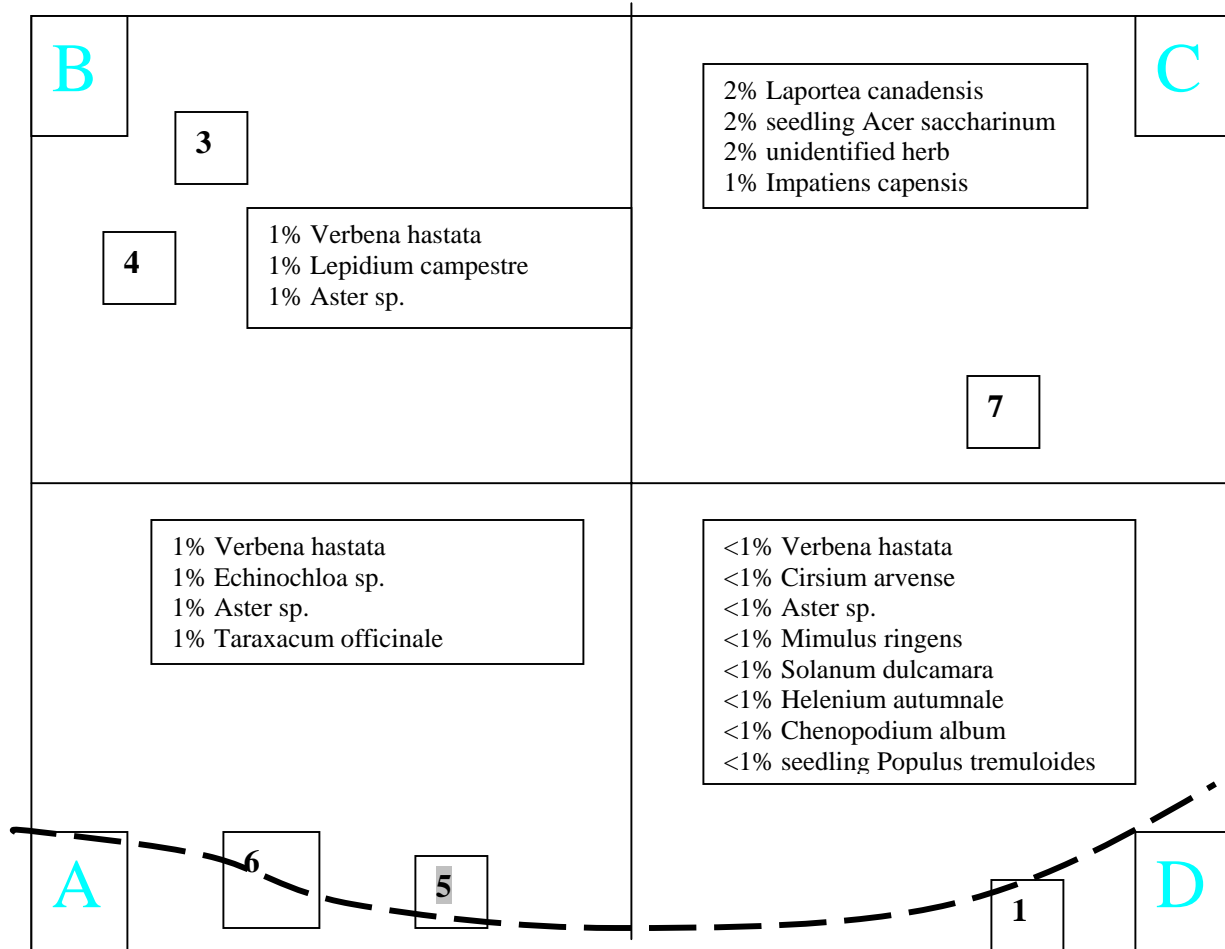


COOPERATIVE LAKE STUDY FIELD MONITORING SHEET



Location: Carcajou Floodplain Forest (N42°52'53.8", W88°58'50.7") Date: 10-31-03
 Observers: Mike Halsted & Steve Hjort Water Level: 775.96 msl
 Conditions: Overcast, 50°F, SW winds from 5-15mph increasing.

Quad A: **5** = Ulmus americana cut by landowner, **6** = 7" (stump) and 18" dbh trunk Acer saccharinum with 1", 1", 1.5" and .75" suckers. Herb layer vegetation present. Evidence of continued erosion.

Quad B: **3** = 18" dbh Fraxinus pennsylvanica. **4** = Fraxinus pennsylvanica. Herb layer vegetation present. Trees healthy.

Quad C: **7** = 22" dbh Acer saccharinum with 0.75", 2.5", 2.5", 2.5", 3", 3.5" suckers. Herb layer vegetation present. Trees healthy.

Quad D: **1** = Acer saccharinum stumps 12", 9", 7", and 6" cut off by landowner. Herb layer vegetation present. Trees healthy. Evidence of continued erosion.

Notes: Water depth 13 inches at 15' mark. Evidence of continued erosion undermining the tree roots along shore.
