ALL INTERESTED PERSONS ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that Rock County and Mead & Hunt, Inc., consulting engineers will host a Public Informational Meeting on **Thursday, April 7, 2016, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.**, at the Fulton Town Hall, located at 2738 West Fulton Center Drive, in Edgerton.

The purpose of this meeting is to present the current design, proposed right-of-way limits, anticipated construction schedule and to answer any questions you may have concerning the roadway rehabilitation project for CTH F. This is the second of two planned public informational meetings for this project. The first meeting was held December 11, 2013. Comments received at this meeting will be considered in the design and included in official project documentation.

The meeting will consist of an open-house format and you may attend anytime between 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. A short presentation will be provided at 6:30 p.m. by Rock County staff and the design consultant. Enclosed is a project location map that shows the public meeting location.

The project includes spot realignments to correct substandard curves. Additional right-of-way is necessary at several of the spot realignment areas. In non-realignment areas the existing asphalt will be milled off and recycled into the new pavement base. The roadside ditches will be improved within the limits of the existing right-of-way.

Within the community of Indianford, the most western street of the existing one-way couples will be converted into a two-way street and include curb and gutter, storm sewer and a sidewalk on one side. The remaining one-way streets will be repaved and remain as one-way streets.

Minor impacts to resources protected by Section 4(f) of the U.S. Department of Transportation Act of 1966 may occur. The Section 4(f) properties include Indianford Park and the Indianford Dam and Powerhouse. Improvements to Indianford Park include repaving the parking lot and adding new sidewalk and storm sewer. The Indianford Dam and Powerhouse are listed on the National Register of Historic Places. ***This notice serves as notification of this project to persons with a concern for or knowledge of historic buildings or structures located along this project.*** Such persons are encouraged to attend this meeting or provide comments. The project activities and potential impacts to the section 4(f) resources will be discussed at this meeting.

The meeting location is handicap accessible. The hearing impaired may contact Mead & Hunt by e-mail or call through the Wisconsin Telecommunications Relay System at (800) 947-3529 to request an interpreter if they plan to attend the meeting.
