Rock River under slow/no wake from Koshkonong to Townline Road

JANESVILLE

Slow/no wake orders have been expanded to include the Rock River between the southern tip of Lake Koshkonong downstream to the Indianford Dam, the Rock County Sheriff's Office announced Wednesday.

The orders could run several days if rains continue as forecast, Capt. Jude Maurer said Wednesday.

The latest slow/no wake order is now posted at public access points and at Dallman's landing at Lake Koshkonong.

Maurer said recent heavy rains had brought the river to 8.37 feet at Lake Koshkonong. At Koshkonong, river levels of 8 feet and higher trigger slow/no wake orders.

Slow/no wake orders put in place earlier this week affect the river from the Indianford Dam downstream to the Beloit-Rock Townline Road bridge south of Janesville, Maurer said.

Maurer said that under a provision of the slow/no wake, the Rock Aqua Jays water ski show team is being allowed to practice on a stretch of the Rock River the team typically uses in Janesville.

More rain is forecast through the rest of this week. Maurer said that could mean slow/no wake orders could continue the next several days.
